South Daytona City, informed me that they were not allowed by their attorney to permit leasing of any of their spaces, she told me that other municipalities may have different policies.

Club Yana Dennis 386-451—7631 they would welcome us in, providing we change our ASC to 1-4 \$15 per mtg \$60 a month they may be room for cabinets with locks for our literature.

Administrative Reports:

Chair Report: Last month I accepted the responsibility of doing a financial inventory of the area. I believed it needed to be connected it to the current adhoc committee already looking into our literature and financial matters so I attended the adhoc meeting on

March 17th. Six addicts were in attendance, Alex (ASC vice chair), Danielle (ASC Treasurer), Tony (ASC Lit Chair), Ron (PR chair), Tina (Last Chance), and me (ASC chair). Danielle was appointed to give a complete financial report on the past 7 months including literature contributions compared to actual literature purchases, and ASC contributions compared to actual ASC expenses. I was to do the same financial report of the previous year. Ron was appointed to do an inventory of PR. Tony and I was appointed to do a complete literature inventory including the total value of that inventory. We agreed the adhoc would meet again on April 7th with our findings. Tony and I met the following Sunday March 20th at the warehouse and counted every piece of literature in stock over a 4 hour period. Tony would complete the inventory by counting all the key tags and medallions, total its value, and also give his opinion on what and how much inventory needs to be kept in stock to better serve the groups and he will give his recommendations in his report. The adhoc met again this past Thursday with 4 addicts present, Tina, Danielle, Ron, and Myself. Ron did a literature inventory of PR and will give it in his report, he also forwarded information from H&I to the adhoc that they were holding a special meeting and had also made contact with each facility regarding literature. I had heard that H&I decided to take limited literature only to facilities that had no access to outside meetings from now on but I will let H&I give a report on the facts of their decisions. Danielle will give a full financial report for the past seven months. One discrepancy we found was that H&I total literature for the year was incorrect and possibly PRs also. The previous H&I chair may not have notified the previous treasurer of taking literature or the literature form may have been taken from area or something else, also all of 09-10's literature order forms were missing, so we could not research it, however I was informed that H&I had used their entire budget each month. My financial report for the previous year is as follows.

Based on just this year, after our regional contribution we had under \$8000.00 to operate with. After these basic needs were met we had about \$3400.00 to operate on.

Adhoc Recommended

1. All admin and subcommittee budgets should be thrown out with exception of what falls under the basic needs listed above. Our current budgets almost triple our projected income for this year. New budgets should be submitted to treasurer to make sure all budgets combined don't exceed our projected income (based on last year of under \$8000) prior to going back to groups to be voted on.
2. Policy should be changed on how we forward funds to region based on taking care of our own area first. We think it wise to forward funds above prudent reserve once per year in December at the end of our fiscal year now. If we can replenish our literature back to a recommended par level and bring our budgets within our ASC group donations we could forward over half our areas contributions again.
3. We strongly recommend revising policy on how or if we should pay traveling/hotel expenses for RCMs or subcommittee chairs. The RCM budget alone last year was over

\$4000 but may have only used \$1200. \$1200 was over 1/3 of our total operating budget after basic needs and we didn't even have an RCM2 that year.

4. We recommend stopping the newsletter to help bring the area to operate within its projected income.
5. We suggest revising literature policy to state that literature forms will not be available at area and that they should be filled out online for accuracy and to eliminate the expense to the area of printing them.
6. We recommend that policy be submitted to replace dollar for dollar all literature distributed each month.
7. We suggest the treasurer redesign/fix the treasurer report database to calculate and forward all subcommittee expenses to the expense total column. As of now it does not.
8. We ask that policy look into all policies regarding spending and that each one be revisited and revised if needed so that we cannot exceed our projected income.

Motions tabled to adhoc

M/S/T: (01/09/04) (Bakers Dozen/Afternoon recovery) That the literature coordinator create a budget to maintain a minimum literature level. Intent: to maintain a level necessary to keep groups supplied with literature. **TABLED TO ADHOC**

Adhoc Opinion The treasurer will be giving a detailed report on how much inventory is in stock, the value of that inventory, and will suggest how much more inventory is needed to maintain sufficient par levels to better serve the groups. From there it will be up to the ASC on whether to purchase the suggested amount when and if DACNA returns a profit in June. As we stated above, last year we used over \$18k in literature, over \$15k was for the groups, and \$3.5k was never replenished. Our projected budget would be at least \$15k for the year if we only serve the groups. We think that this information and the literature chair report today exceed the request of this motion. If the maker is satisfied we would ask him to withdraw the motion.

M/S/T: (11/02/03) (New Attitudes/Literature) To change on a trial basis, the process in which the Daytona Area orders pay for and distribute literature. Temporary suspension of current literature policy may be necessary. The trial will be a least 6 months in duration or longer if necessary. The start date to be determined on ASC floor when the current literature situation is resolved (back orders filled, bills paid, etc) and the group[s] have ample notice to plan for this new process. The new process is as much, the groups will bring their literature orders to ASC as they do now and pay for the order and pick up their orders at the next ASC. **Intent:** To be prudent with NA funds and hopefully eliminate the financial burden on the Area Treasurer by atleast having the money in place to pay for what is ordered up front at time of purchase. (Concept 11), To eliminate any unnecessary inventory and the uncertainty of what and how much literature to purchase (Concept 11) To help streamline the literature ordering process and help ease the heavy responsibilities of the literature trusted servants.

Policy which may be affected: Literature (pg 20) Maintains distributes orders and fills all literature orders at ASC. 04-07-06 Literature and alternate literature to separate position from treasurer. Duties

include 1) ordering literature 2) Inventory 3) check order 4) attend area 5) submit invoice 6) fill orders 7) special orders when requested in advance 8) transport literature to and from area 1yr clean.

The Groups should keep a copy of their order to make sure their order is correct at pick-up and to use when ordering for the next month. **TABLE TO ADHOC**

Adhoc Opinion We see no real financial prudence to this motion. The literature will cost the same to the groups whether we stock it to have readily available or each group figure out what it needs two months in advance. If par levels are achieved and, a policy dictate, we replenish dollar for dollar what we distribute, including every piece taken from a subcommittee or new group, we may only have to increase the par levels minimally as this area grows. We don't think it streamlines the process for the groups or the literature chair. We also believe that there are many items that the groups don't know exist, wouldn't purchase without seeing it first, and would like our trusted literature chair to have the ability to order just a couple of such new things as they come out. Many addicts won't ever know what's available if they don't see it here in our area. We also don't believe literature has ever contributed to any of our current financial situation, but seems to be the one area affected by it. It is up to the maker to move forward with this motion or not.
