**M/S/T (09/12/07a) (Treasurer/Policy)\*TABLED TO POLICY\*** To include in the Daytona Area Policy a sub-section titled TRAVEL POLICY, to be implemented by the ASC Administrative Committee and all Sub-committees and Trusted Servants of the Area. (see attached Proposed Travel Policy.)

This Travel Policy will effect/change/delete/ amend the following current ASC Policies/motion. The effected Policies/motions are:

- 04-08-03: RCM budget approved \$120.00 for male room and \$120.00 for female room on Saturday of RSC weekend. An additional male and female room approved at \$120.00 on Friday nights, when meetings are 100 miles or more away from ASC meeting place.  
(effect-moved & combined)
- 04-10-08: ASC to provide lodging expenses for sub-committee chairs to attend RSC (not to exceed \$120.00-1 room night) 1 male, 1 female if necessary when RSC is at least 100 miles away.  
(effect-moved & combined)
- 05-08-07: Daytona ASC will provide compensation for some of the gasoline cost that RCM's and chairpersons of H&I, PI, and Helpline incur when traveling over 100 miles to the RSC. A sum of up to \$300.00 or \$.32 cents per mile in total, whichever comes first, for combined travel amongst all trusted servants.  
(effect-amended & moved)
- 08-01-03: Change Policy that trusted servants travel reimbursement be at the current prevailing IRS rate at the time of travel.  
(effect-amended & combined)
- 08-04-02: Change Policy to show trusted servants mileage reimbursement when meetings are from 100 miles to 50 miles from the ASC meeting place.  
(effect-combined)

**INTENT:** This proposed Travel Policy is intended to provide clear guidelines in regards to travel reimbursement to make better the most efficient use of our fellowship funds. Keeping with the guidance and guidelines of our Eleventh Concept: NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose and must be managed responsibly.

## **PROPOSED TRAVEL POLICY**

### **Purpose**

*The primary purpose of a Travel Policy is to create guidelines to provide oversight, enhance accountability and transparency of all financial matters regarding travel of the DASC.*

*In keeping with the spirit of our Traditions, Concepts and the Guide To Local Service.*

*Eleventh Concept- NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly. The Eleventh Concept establishes the sole absolute priority for the use of NA funds: to carry the message. The importance of that priority calls for total fiscal accountability.*

*Intent & Purpose: No addict with the willing to serve be excluded because of his or her financial situation.*

**Trusted Servants who travel at the direction of the ASC shall have all necessary and reasonable expenses paid. These may include:**

#### **1. Transportation**

- Compensation for use of a personal vehicle shall be no more than one half (1/2) of the current IRS Standard Mileage Rate for business miles driven over 50 miles from ASC meeting place, up to \$300.00 total, whichever come first, for combined travel amongst all trusted servants.
- Tolls

- Parking (limited to the destination hotel)
- Bus fare (not to exceed the same cost of 1/2 of the current IRS Standard Mileage Rate.)

## 2. Lodging

- Room rates not to exceed \$120.00 a night-one male room, and (only when/if necessary)-one female room.
- Friday night room for RCM 1&2 and H&I and PR Sub-Committee Chairperson to attend the Saturday RSC Area Support Group & Fellowship Development Group, providing RSC is over 100 miles from the ASC meeting place.
- Saturday night room for RCM 1&2 to attend Regional Service Conference.

## 3. Meals

- not to exceed \$15.00 per day.

**An estimated advance of funds shall be made upon request.**

**Each Trusted Servant shall submit a detailed expense related report on the Check Request Form along with all receipts, and return any unused advanced funds at the next ASC meeting.**

**It is the responsibility of the traveling trusted servant to make the most efficient use of Fellowship funds. This may be done by:**

- **Sharing resources- Ask fellow addicts for help, sharing hotel room, stay overnight at an addict's home, pack a meal.**

**M/S/D (09/12/08) (Welcome Home/Afternoon Recovery)** To revise motion 06-01-02 to read: Daytona ASC shall send monies above prudent reserve and after financial obligations have been met on a quarterly basis, every March, June, September and December with 75% going to Florida RSC and 25% to NAWS. INTENT: To further out 11<sup>th</sup> concept and help support NA as a whole.
